2312 CLASS SIZE

The size of any class in the district will be determined by the Board after consideration of administrative recommendations. Factors which will enter into class size determinations include:

- 1. The chronological and developmental age of the students.
- 2. Specific educational needs of students.
- 3. Current educational theory and research.
- 4. Safety factors in lab classes.
- 5. State regulations and size and availability of classroom space.
- 6. Financial considerations (i.e. elimination of other programs; budget limitations).
- 7. Schoolwide scheduling implications and curriculum implementation.

The Board and administration will make every reasonable effort to see that class sizes stay within the levels listed below.
