Restart and Recovery Plan

1648R RESTART AND RECOVERY PLAN

The Department of Education's The Road Back: Restart and Recovery Plan For Education (hereinafter "the Guidance") required all New Jersey schools to adopt policies related to safe school operations. The Guidance requires the Board of Education to adopt certain policies to address those policy requirements contained in the Guidance and the school district adopted Policy 1648 for this purpose. Policy 1648 shall only be effective through the current COVID-19 pandemic and will take precedence over any existing Policy on the same or similar subject, unless determined otherwise by the Superintendent.

In the event that the District receives guidance from the New Jersey Department of Health and/or local health department, or further guidance by Executive Order that would justify adjusting requirements related to the Guidance, or other health guidance related to, but not limited to, building capacity limits, social distancing, or face coverings, the chief school administrator may adopt a temporary policy that shall remain in effect until such time as the Board may adopt a revised policy.
