

## Can I visit the school?



An open house (for parents only) is held every January. Parents are encouraged to attend and ask the teacher any questions. **Applications** and **registration** information can be found on the [website or at the open house](#). The students are invited to visit the classroom just before school begins.

## How do I register?

Applications are taken in January and February with a non-refundable deposit of \$100. Registration is accepted as long as space is available. If needed, students will be selected using a lottery system in February.

Once selected, families must provide the necessary residency and other registration documents to the school office. The first tuition payment is due by August 1<sup>st</sup>.



## Who is eligible to attend?



The preschool program is open to all Roseland residents turning 3 or 4 years old by October 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Is transportation provided?



Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from the preschool program.

### Dramatic Play Area:

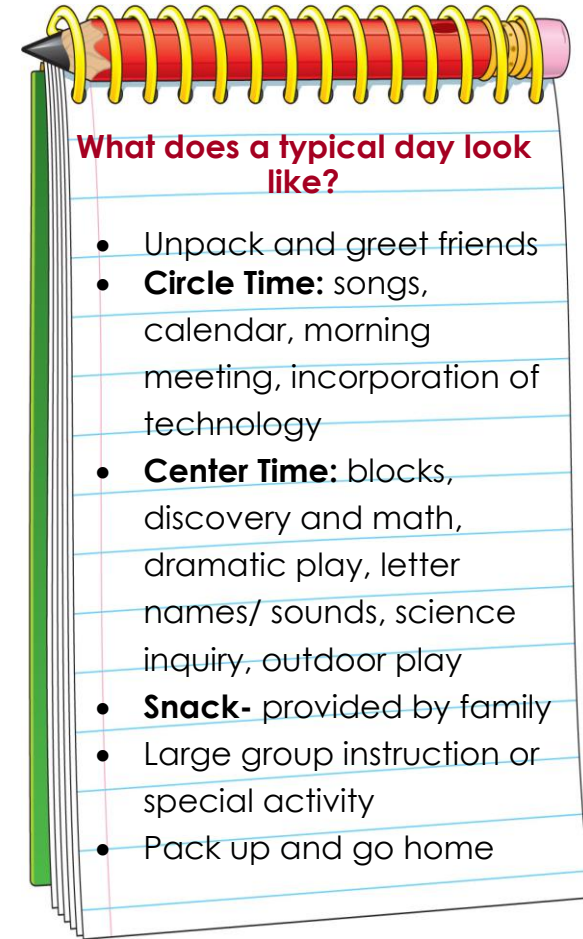
- Imagination and creativity
