Connection: Suicide and HIB

Rates of suicide ideation are much higher in students who have been bullied

The NJ ABR Law and HIB procedures are aimed at

- protecting students
- educating students
- and preventing mental health issues.

Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights (ABR) Act

The goal of the ABR Act was to strengthen the standards and procedures for *preventing*, *reporting*, *investigating* and *responding to* incidents of harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB) of students that occur on school grounds* and off school grounds under specified circumstances (2010, with amendments in 2012, 2022).

Annual Self-Assessment is intended to help the school district *evaluate efforts in implementing the ABR*. Through its School Safety Team, each school is required to evaluate the implementation of the ABR from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. The Self-Assessment tool includes eight core elements that address all of the ABR requirements for schools.






